

# HIGH POINT PRESERVE

The 49.9-acre High Point Preserve is a hilly, mature forest that features pitch pine, oak, beech, hickory and maple and at its summit provides an expansive view of Three Mile Harbor. The trails of the preserve connect to the Paumanok Path and provide valuable habitat for a wide variety of sensitive species including the red-tailed hawk, great horned owl, American kestrel and downy woodpecker.

The preserve was donated to the Peconic Land Trust by Maggie de Cuevas in February of 2003. We thank her for her tremendous gift to the community.

The North Amagansett area of East Hampton has benefited tremendously through the generosity and conservation-mindedness of many. This dedication has secured the conservation of over 600 acres of woodlands. The land is part of the Town of East Hampton's Water Recharge Overlay District, sitting above the sole source aquifer in Amagansett.

Through land conservation, we are all working together to improve the quality of our important water and natural resources.

La High Point Preserve, de 49,9 acres, es un bosque maduro y ondulado que cuenta con pinos piñoneros, robles, hayas, nogales y arces, y en su cima ofrece una amplia vista del Three Mile Harbor. Los senderos de la reserva se conectan con el Paumanok Path y bindan un valioso hábitat para una gran variedad de especies sensibles, como el halcón de cola roja, el búho real, el cernícalo americano y el pájaro carpintero.

La reserva fue donada al Peconic Land Trust por Maggie de Cuevas en febrero de 2003. Le agradecemos su enorme regalo a la comunidad.

La zona de North Amagansett, de East Hampton, se ha beneficiado enormemente de la generosidad y la mentalidad conservacionista de muchos. Esta dedicación ha garantizado la conservación de más de 600 acres de bosques. Estos terrenos forman parte del Town of East Hampton's Water Recharge Overlay District y se encuentran por encima del único acuífero de Amagansett.

A través de la conservación de la tierra, todos trabajamos juntos para mejorar la calidad de nuestros importantes recursos naturales y de agua.
