**Beginning in 2003** at the barn of **Leandro and Beverley Galban in Sagaponack**, *Through Farms and Fields* has been held at some of the most beautiful locations on the East End, including the **Channing Sculpture Garden in Bridgehampton**; the **Salm’s Port of Missing Men in North Sea**; Kelly Klein’s **Wild Ocean Farm in Bridgehampton**; Rich Hogan and Carron Sherry’s historic property **Ward’s Point on Shelter Island**; **Russ McCall’s Corchaug Estate Vineyard and Ranch in Cutchogue**; **Quail Hill Farm in Amagansett**; the Halsey family’s **Whitecap Farm in Water Mill**; and most recently, Prudence Wickham Heston and Dan Heston’s **Salt Air Farm**, in Cutchogue.

This year, we return to one of our favorite locations, the **Wesnofske farm fields and historic barn at Ocean View Farm in Bridgehampton**. The Wesnofskes are long-time supporters of the Trust and Ocean View Farm on Scuttlehole Road is the ideal place to celebrate our rich rural heritage.
